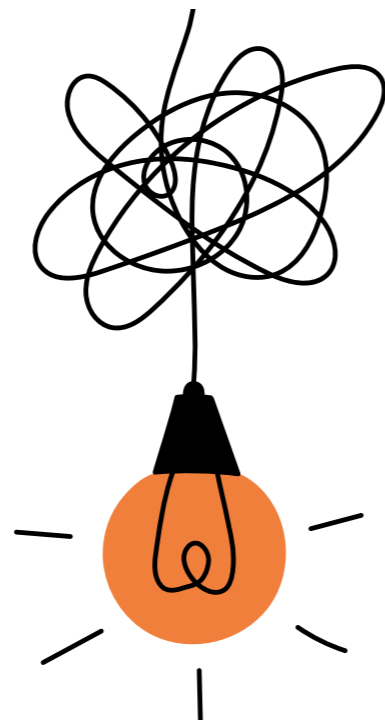

The first step to access the services



Ulss 3 Serenissima

Ulss 3 Serenissima is the public company that **guarantees access** to healthcare services **for all Italian citizens, foreigners and their families that live in the relevant Venetian territory**. Ulss 3, in performing healthcare services, takes as its reference principle **respect for the person** with all his characteristics: culture, language, religion, gender, origin, political opinions, etc. Ulss 3 ensures specific attention to citizens heading from another country, so that they can gain access in an **informed, equal and effective manner respectful of their particular condition**.

The first step to take in order to access healthcare services is **compulsory free of charge registration, which allows the choice of doctor and paediatrician**. This registration is open to **non-EU citizens in possession of a residence permit** for work purposes, family reasons, asylum, pending adoption or the acquisition of citizenship, or special cases. A specific and full list and the documents required for each category of residence permit is found in Resolution no. 753/2019 of the Regional Council of Veneto.

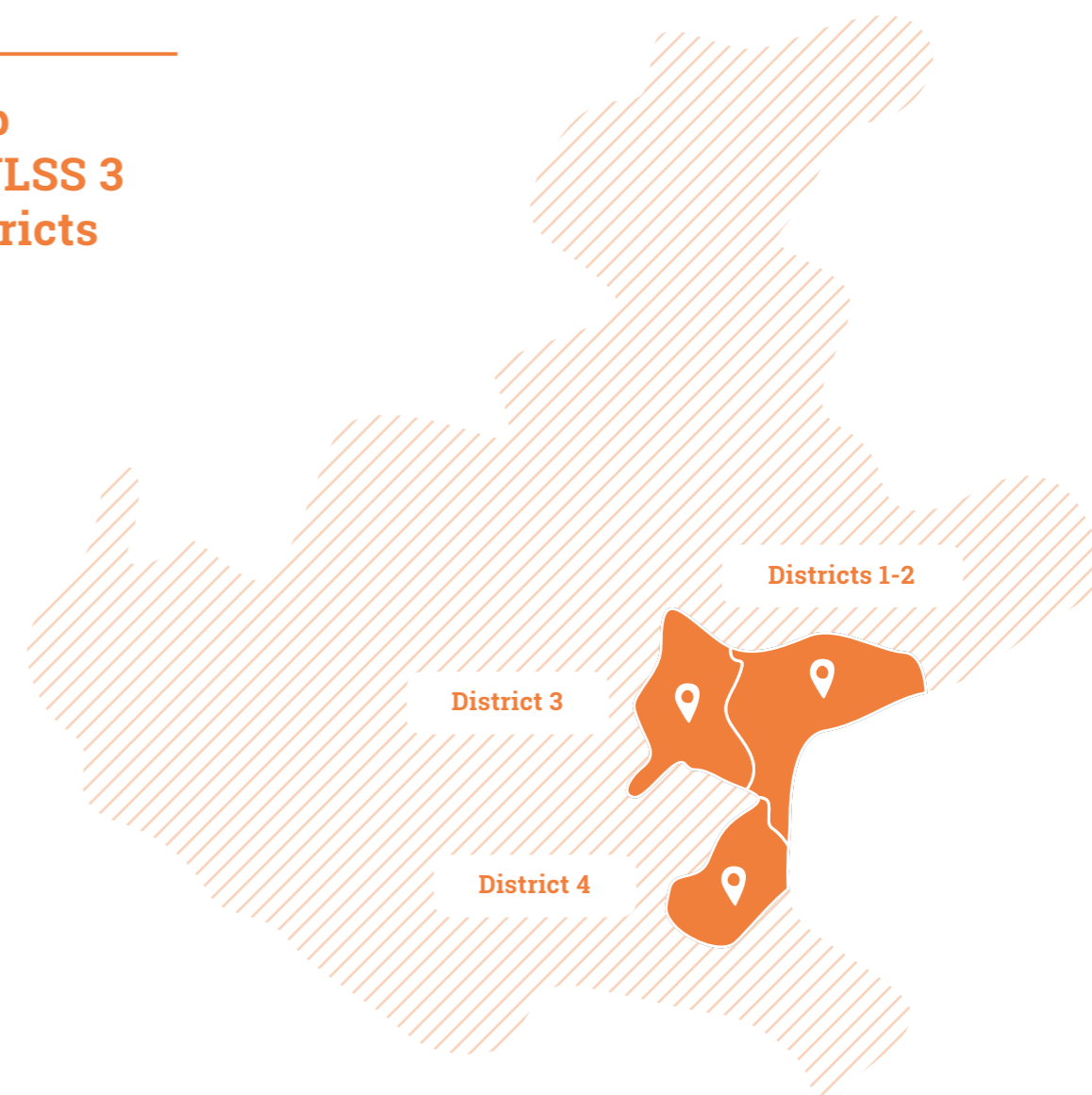
Even family members **over 65, reunited with non-EU citizens residing here**, may access compulsory free of charge healthcare, in the forms regulated by Regional Council Resolution no. 578 of 04/05/2021.

For registration procedures, contact the **Ulss 3 Health Registry Offices located in every District**. Registration and health insurance card normally have the same duration as the residence permit, save for specific cases laid down by the Regional Council Resolution.

Voluntary healthcare

To be able to use the healthcare services, non-EU citizens whose residence permits do not allow compulsory registration (e.g. visit, study permits and others) must resort to **voluntary paid registration with the National Health Service** at the Ulss counters or to private insurance.

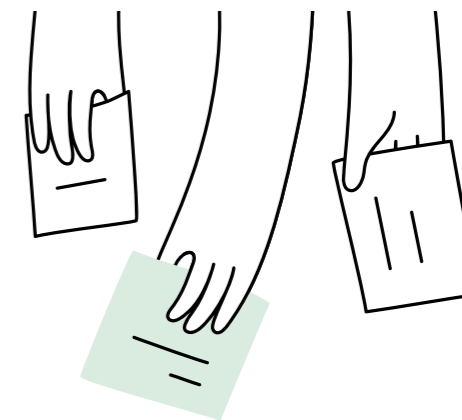

Registering with the health registry and obtaining the health insurance card

how to do?



A

The following documents are required to register for the 1st time with the healthcare service, if one is in possession of a residence permit for work purposes:

- Valid **residence permit**;
- If the permit is under renewal, **copy of the expired residence permit and receipt of the application for renewal** (kit issued by the Post Office);
- An **identity document**: passport or identity card or receipt from the Municipality of the application for a new identity card;
- **Certificate of residence or self-certification** in case the citizen is already resident; if the person is domiciled, a hospitality declaration endorsed by the Police Station (in the provincial capital) or by the Local Public Security Authority (in the other Municipalities);
- **Tax code**.

B

The following documents are required to register for the 1st time with the healthcare service, in the event of residence permit for family reasons:

- **Identity document**;
- **Tax code** or self-certification;
- **Copy of visa for family reunification**;
- **Copy of clearance**;
- Valid **residence permit**;
- **Certificate of residence or self-certification**, failing which a **hospitality declaration** endorsed by the Police Station or by the Local Public Security Authority;
- **Documentation certifying the status of dependant family member** where required.

C

The following documents are required for a newborn at 1st registration:

- **Residence permit and mother's health insurance card**;
- **Passport** or mother's identity document;
- **Affidavit in lieu of the child's birth certificate**.

D

Registration in the event of residence permit for the purpose of applying for international protection:

In the event of residence permit **to apply for international protection/asylum** or **Dublin Regulation** permits:

- **Identity document** (if any);
- Provisional numerical **tax code** or alphanumeric tax code;
- Valid **residence permit**;
- **Certificate of residence or hospitality declaration** endorsed by the Police Station or by the Local Public Security Authority.

E

For people without residence documents: STP (Temporarily Present Foreigners) cards and pregnancy protection

People who do not have a valid residence document and are in conditions of poverty **are guaranteed urgent and essential outpatient clinic and hospital treatments, as well as preventive medicine programs.**

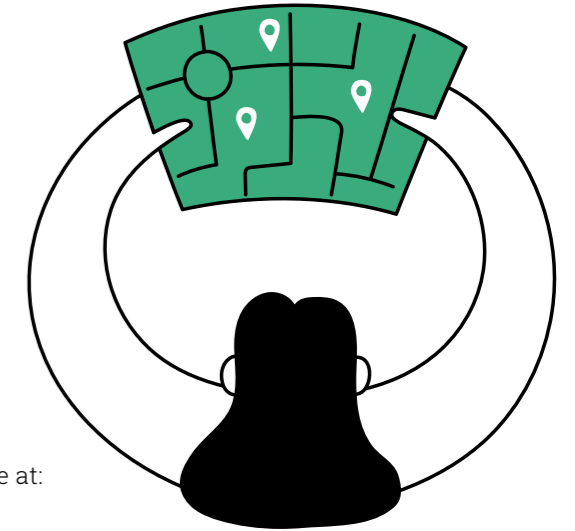
In these cases, the person concerned is given an individual card of **Temporarily Present Foreigner (STP)**. Throughout Ulss 3 Districts, the card is issued at the health registry office.

Pregnant women without valid residence **are guaranteed by the State a specific legal cover** (a residence permit for the mother valid for up to 6 months of the newborn), while the Ulss simultaneously guarantees for the same period **complete free of charge health cover for both mother and child.**

In this instance, the health card is issued at the health registry office along with the following documents:

- **Residence permit for pregnancy** or application for the same, which will be issued by the Police Station pursuant to a pregnancy certificate provided or validated by the Counselling Clinic or another public health facility;
- **Hospitality declaration** endorsed by the Police Station or by the Local Public Security Authority;
- **Identity document.**

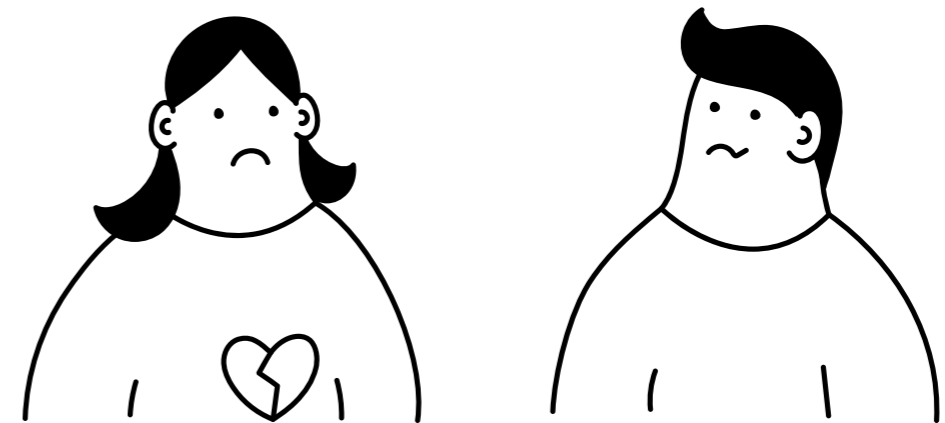

Family counselling clinic

It is a **health-and-social care service addressed to individuals, couples and families** dealing with issues concerned with emotional, sexual and relational life, responsible procreation, maternity and paternity, parenthood, protection of women's health, prevention and treatment of disorders affecting the female's reproductive system, and voluntary interruption of pregnancy.

It also deals with conflict situations, such as separation, divorce, domestic violence and abuse.

All services performed by the Family Counselling Clinic are free of charge; there is no need for a referral from the General Practitioner. Appointments for pregnancies may be requested within the 12th week, after the lab test has already been taken.

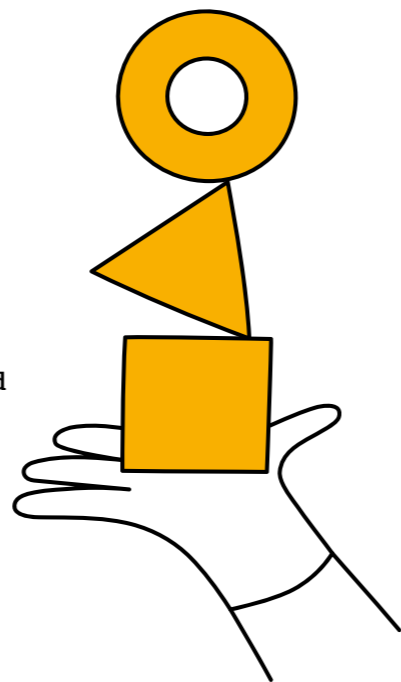

Child neuropsychiatry

It is a specialised service addressed at **children and adolescents between 0 and 17 years with development disorders** (disability, cognitive or motor retardation, attention and learning disorders), including those associated with mood or nutrition and psychosis.

It furthermore deals with the certification process to facilitate **inclusion and attendance** across the different school levels for **children with disabilities**.

Access to Child Neuropsychiatry might be **by prescription from a paediatrician** or general practitioner, or free **at the request of the parent** or legal guardian.

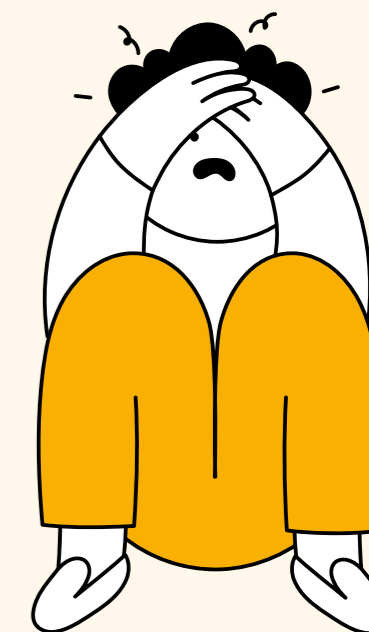

Development age/adolescent centre

It is a specialised service addressed at **adolescents from 12 to 21 years for the prevention and treatment of psychopathological and psychiatric disorders**.

Access to the Development Age-Adolescent Centre Service is **free of charge**; two options are envisaged:

1. **Direct access by boys/girls who have reached 14** for queries related to sexuality, contraception, pregnancies or adolescent crisis.
2. **Access by appointment by the parent or legal guardian** of boys/girls between 12 and 17 years old when the child has a behavioural, mood, nutritional or anxiety disorder.

Casualty

Useful information



What is Casualty?

Casualty (PS) is a **healthcare facility devoted to emergency** (life-threatening) **situations and urgent ones** (conditions that could become critical due to a rapid evolution in conditions of vital instability).

What is needed to show up at Casualty?

You are advised to bring along:

- **Identity document;**
- **Health insurance card (team) ;**
- **Ctax code.**

Who will receive you?

An expert nurse receives the patient and assesses the symptoms/signs to be able to allocate the Priority Code. At this stage, called **Triage**, life-threatening **situations** (characterised by red, orange and yellow codes) **are identified as priorities**, followed by other **non-urgent problems** (green or white code).

Waiting in Casualty

In Casualty, **access to medical consultation** does not **follow** the patients' order of arrival, but **the urgency** (the risk of evolution) of his symptoms/presentation signs. **The order of access to treatments is thus governed by the priority code**, allocated at the Triage.

Priority code

It is a code established through internationally recognised criteria, common to all hospitals. The code is **represented by 5 colours allowing a classification based on the urgency of the visit for all patients who arrive at Casualty.**

The colors of the priority code



RED CODE

Requires **immediate assistance, with absolute priority**, since the user presents one or more alterations of the vital functions (consciousness, breathing, circulation), and is therefore **in danger of life**. The other waiting patients will be informed of any "Emergency in progress" **that might slow down the activity**.

ORANGE CODE

Situations in which the problem the patient presented on arrival has a **high likelihood of developing into a life-threatening situation**; these users, too, are looked after quickly.

YELLOW CODE

Situations in which the problem the patient presented on arrival **has a low likelihood of developing into a life-threatening situation**.

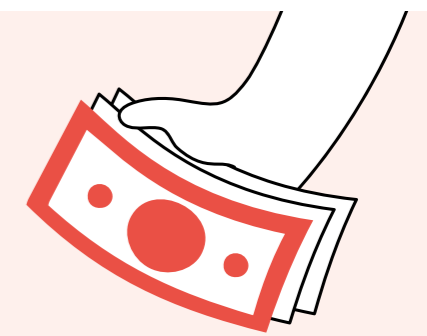
GREEN CODE

Comprises **acute situations**, with possible serious acute damage to one or more organs, **but without the possibility of jeopardising vital functions**.

WHITE CODE

Comprises all other situations. Many cases with this CODE could be handled by the general practitioner. These cases **will only be attended to subsequently to the other codes**, which means that the wait might be considerably prolonged. If the allocated white CODE is confirmed by the visiting doctor, all Casualty services (including diagnostic investigations) **will be subject to payment of prescription charges**, save for those cases where there is a right to exemption.

Documentation and payments



1

Documentation issued at the end of the Emergency Room operation

Upon discharge from Casualty, you will be handed the **documentation relating to all consultations and tests performed**, together with any INAIL and INPS certifications, if need be, and the general practitioner's recommendations.

2

Payment of Casualty services

No services are paid in Casualty, save for those to which a "White Code" has been assigned on discharge. Prescription charges derive from the sum of the different healthcare services performed and is only a share (a part) in the total cost.

3

Exempted from payment of prescription charges

Fully exempt users do not have to pay anything, white codes included. Whoever has a partial exemption for a specific pathology is exempted from payment of prescription charges only as regards services performed in relation to that pathology.

4

Specific conditions for people without health insurance card

Assistance at Casualty is free for everyone. **Citizens without health insurance card must pay for the service in full regardless of the priority code assigned to them.** Urgent services and those relating to infectious diseases must be guaranteed to foreigners who have signed a declaration of indigence and have been assigned the S.T.P. (Temporarily Present Foreigner) regional code. Services must also be guaranteed to pregnant women and minors under 18 years of age.

Round the clock service, Emergency doctor

The round the clock service (formerly Emergency Doctor) **ensures basic medical assistance by way of telephone consultation, outpatient clinic or house call at the doctor's discretion**, for all urgent situations (yet not so serious that Casualty should be contacted) occurring at night or on days before holidays and holidays, **when**, in other words, **it is not possible to contact one's general practitioner or paediatrician of choice**.

The service is available:

- Every day from 8:00pm to 8:00am;
- On days preceding holidays from 10:00am to 8:00am of the next day;
- On holidays from 8:00am to 8:00pm.

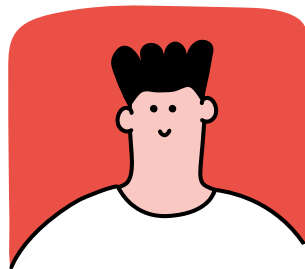
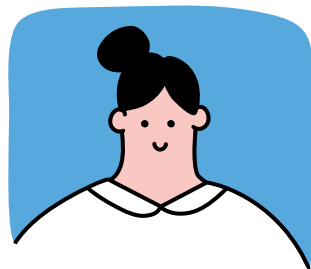
